Arrival of **His Majesty** at Dunblane.

He will be received by the Lord Lieutenant of the County.

The Lord Lieutenant will then present the
Provost of Dunblane, who will hand to **His Majesty**
an address from the Burgh.

The Sheriff of the County and the
General Commanding in Chief, Scottish Command,
will also be present on the platform.

His Majesty will then be conducted to his carriage
by the Lord Lieutenant.

His Majesty will, *en route*, visit the Cathedral.

1.5 p.m.

Arrival of **His Majesty** at the School, accompanied by
the Lord Lieutenant and Suite.

Reception of **His Majesty** by the
President of the Council, the Senior Vice-President,
the Chairman of Executive Committee,
the Honorary Treasurer, and the Commandant.

An Address to **His Majesty** will be read
by the Honorary Treasurer, Mr R. Addison Smith,
and will then be handed to the
President of the Council, The Earl of Rosebery,
who will present it to **His Majesty**.

His Majesty will graciously reply.

Sir Robert Cranston, Chairman of Building Committee,
will then hand a Gold Key to **His Majesty**
who will open the door of the building.

His Majesty,
accompanied by the President of the Council, the
Senior Vice-President, the Members of the
Building and Arrangements Committees,
and the Commandant, will
inspect the Buildings.

Thereafter **His Majesty** will walk to the site of the
Chapel to lay the Foundation Stone of the
Memorial to the Sailors and Soldiers who died in
the South African War.

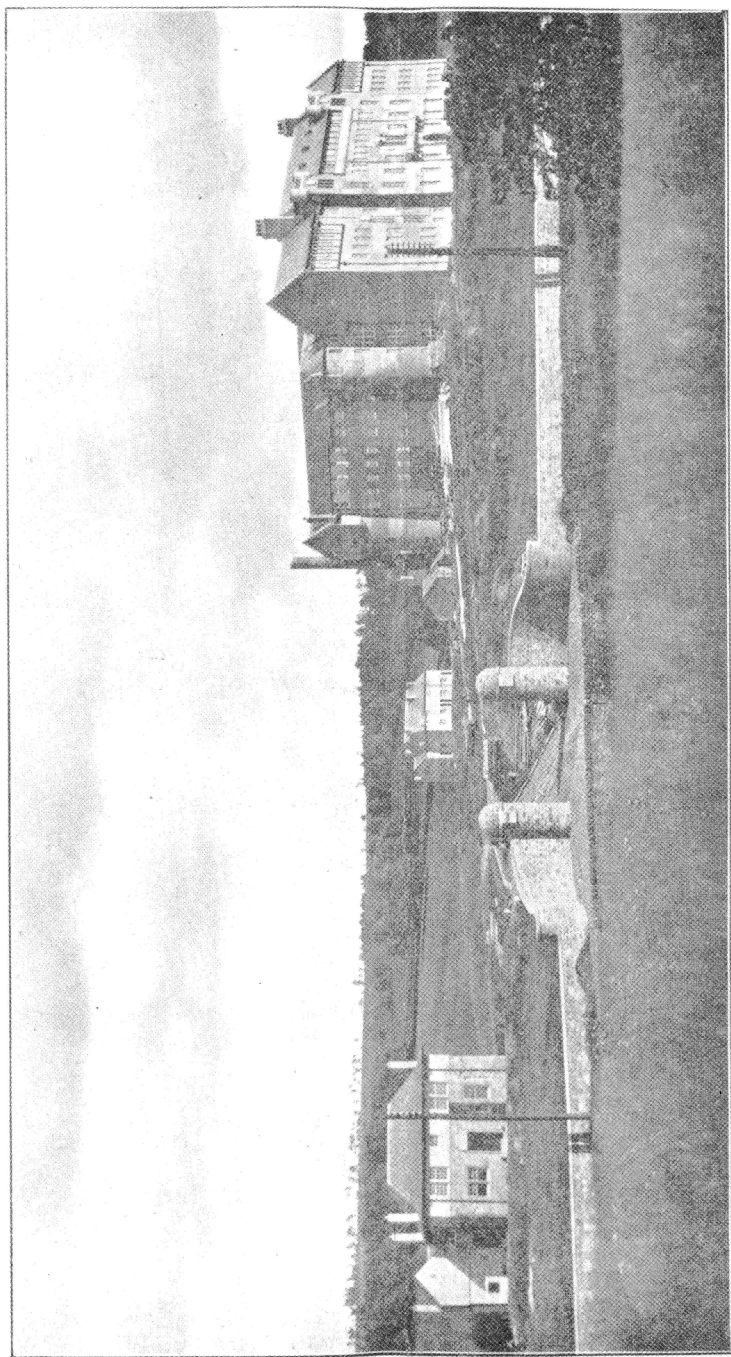
The Rev. Alex. Ritchie, B.D., Dunblane,
